This unique exhibition of contemporary Dutch design will be the first in Slovakia to explore the exceptional works by interior designers created in 1970 – 2006.

It brings the visitors carefully selected products of top design by the world's most recognized Dutch brands (Artifort, Designum, Spectrum etc.) and Designers, as well as complex design solutions of interiors presented through images and videos. We will also see graphic design used in home creations (posters and publications) and product branding (collection made for Heineken).

The exhibition is composed of combinations of furniture, wall and floor coverings, lighting objects and interior accessories to create meaningful and topical expositions, which aim to pull the visitor "into the story". Thus we will not see a traditional presentation of objects with their description labels, but a lively, interactive, much more interesting way of displaying that should facilitate understanding and interpretation of new European design trends.
