# Olav Kristoffersen /NO/ BRENDLAND & KRISTOFFERSEN ARKITEKTER AS

Štúdio **Brendland & Kristoffersen architects** založili Olav Kristoffersen a Geir Brendland v roku 2002 po tom, čo vyhrali otvorenú súťaž na projekt sociálneho bývania v Trondheime. Tento projekt sa dostal do užšieho výberu prestížnej ceny Mies van der Rohe Award 2007. Väčšina ich realizovaných prác bola publikovaná či vystavovaná v Nórsku i v zahraničí, v roku 2012 taktiež na Bienále architektúry v Benátkach. Medzi ich posledné projekty patrí aj Villa Nilsen/Borgen v Trondheime, ktorú môžete vidieť na výstave v design factory.

**Olav Kristoffersen** vyštudoval architektúru na Norwegian University of Science and Technology v Trondheime, kde neskôr aj pôsobil ako lektor. Spolupracoval aj s ďalšími architektonickými školami v Škandinávii, Veľkej Británii, Nemecku, Taliansku a Kanade. Aktuálne prednáša na Oslo School of Architecture.

## Villa Borgen/Nilsen, Trondheim, 2008



**Brendland & Kristoffersen architects** was founded by Olav Kristoffersen and Geir Brendland in 2002 after winning an open architectural competition for social housing in Trondheim. This project got shortlisted in the prestigious Mies van der Rohe Award in 2007. Most of their built works have been published and exhibited extensively in Norway and internationally, including at the Architecture Biennale in Venice 2012. Recent projects include the Villa Nilsen/Borgen which is part of the exhibition presented in design factory.

**Olav Kristoffersen** studied architecture at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology in Trondheim, where he has later led several master courses. He contributed as a lecturer also at architecture schools in Scandinavia, UK, Germany, Italy and Canada. He currently teaches at the Oslo School of Architecture.
